Dear AeroStars,

This time last year, our beloved AeroStar donors responded to our call for donations, and we were blown away! Little did we know, their generosity would help us make 2020 (our most challenging year yet) a success. When schools were forced to close their doors due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we launched the AeroVerse E-Learning Academy so that our students could continue to learn and move toward the aviation and aerospace careers of their dreams!

During this giving season, I'd like to take this moment to personally request your support once again. Let me explain why your generosity is more urgent than ever before.

For the past decade, AeroStar has embarked on the biggest, the boldest, the most ambitious construction project of a lifetime. We are building a

school-to-work talent pipeline connecting students in underrepresented communities to careers in aviation and aerospace.

These communities contain a goldmine of STEM talent. Yet, in the aviation industry, it has been extremely difficult for minorities and females to compete for well-paying careers. Of all airline pilots and flight engineers:

- 93.7% are white, but only...
- 3.4% are Asian.
- 2.6% are black or African American.
- 2.2% are Hispanic or Latino.
- Only 7.9% of pilots and 4.3% of flight engineers are women.
- Less than 1% of pilots are African American women.

Not only is AeroStar providing training and mentoring for students K–12, college, and beyond, we are diversifying the labor force in a powerful way.

Our students are not looking for a handout. We're training them to fill a critical need in America's workforce. Over the next ten years, "educational outreach and career pathway programs will be essential to inspiring and recruiting the next generation" of aviation professionals (Boeing's Pilot and Technician Outlook 2020–2039).

The AeroVerse E-Learning Academy is right on time...

"Amid challenges posed by COVID-19, the training industry has begun to adopt increasingly innovative solutions. Many providers have transitioned their offerings to online and virtual formats where possible, allowing students to continue their learning safely. Immersive technologies, adaptive learning and flexible distance learning methods are also being explored to enable optimum learning and knowledge retention. Investments in technology that are being made today will likely lead to a long-term fundamental shift in how training is conducted" (Boeing).

Our Bold Vision for 2021

Training will continue in the AeroVerse E-Learning Academy, and when schools return to in-person learning, we will be there to provide the hands-on training and mentoring students have enjoyed for more than a decade.

Also in 2021, we will embark on our most ambitious project yet. We will launch apprenticeship programs in Aircraft Maintenance and Flight! Apprenticeships are a critical component in American workforce development. Last month saw movement in the Congress to reauthorize the National Apprenticeship Act (H.R. 8294). Our apprenticeship programs place AeroStar at the forefront and leading edge of workforce development in the aviation and aerospace industries.

He is the first African American astronaut to serve on the manned satellite for a six-month tour of duty. On December 3rd, students across the nation had a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to speak to him live from the Space Station on NASA TV!
