Chicago Officials Unveil New Concession Area at Midway Airport



Chicago Mayor Brandon Johnson celebrated the reopening of Midway International Airport's Central Market and the completion of the \$400 million Midway Modernization Program. The program emphasizes diverse local businesses, with over 56% of Midway's concessions operated by firms with diverse ownership in 2023. The revamped Central Market features a mix of new and existing brands, contributing to the airport's total concessions area expanding from 40,000 to over 70,000 square feet. Future plans include additional retail and food and beverage locations, as well as the opening of Midway's first lounge, The Club MDW, in the Central Market next fall.


Peloton Awards AeroStar Fitness Accessories to Promote Health and Wellness

About GEO-Scholarship Program

The GEO-Scholarship targets graduating high school seniors and degree seeking college students with less than 45 credits that are majoring in areas of study NGA deems as a critical need and are typically difficult to recruit. NGA offers tuition payment, a book stipend, and a paid summer internship for all scholars. Some scholars may also qualify for a travel stipend. All selected scholars are required to commit to a 1.5-year continuing service agreement post-graduation. This agreement states for every year NGA pays tuition, that scholar will commit 1.5-years of service post-graduation.

Awardees will onboard with NGA in August 2024, attend school during the Fall 2024 and Spring 2025 semesters, and return to NGA for their summer internship in summer 2025.
